



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Families accepted into the PKC program must meet financial eligibility guidelines.

Families are selected by need and not the date an application was received.

Families whose children are selected for the Pre-K Counts program must provide transportation on a daily basis to and from the school.

Families must attend parent-teacher conferences and some meetings throughout the school year.

Attendance is essential. Except for illness, children must arrive promptly and be present on a daily basis.

▶ What is Pre-K Counts?

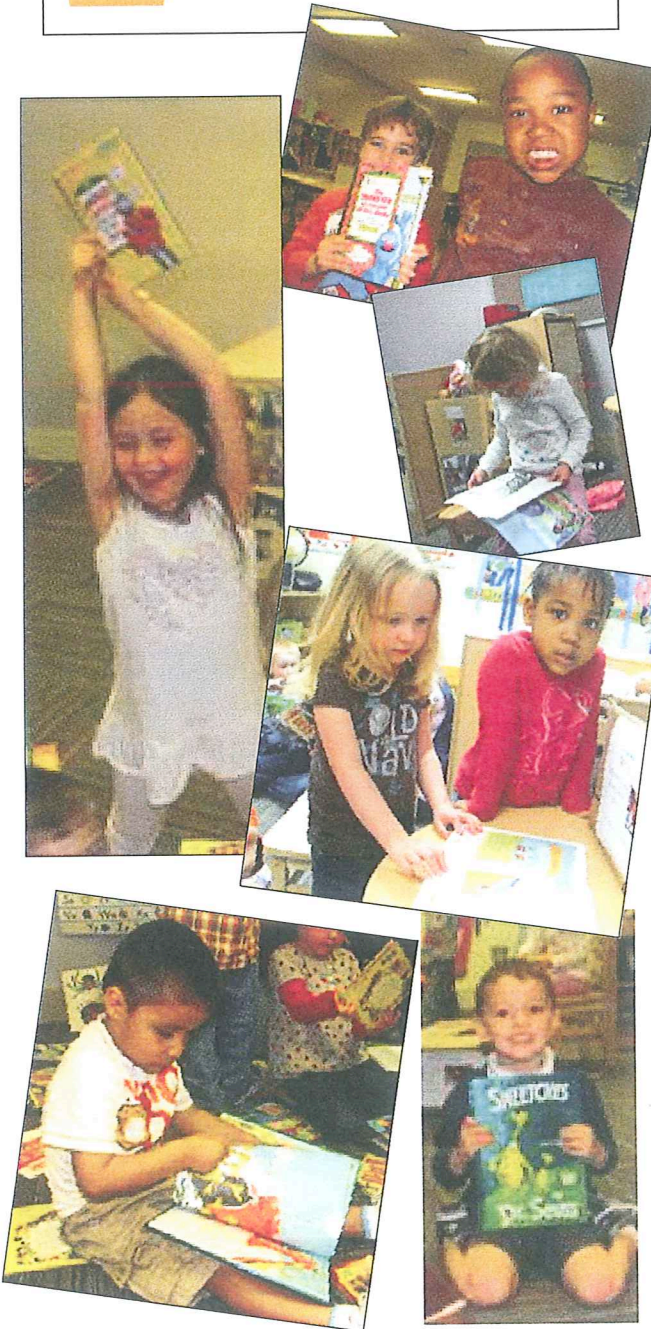
Pre-K Counts is a grant from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that makes high quality pre-school education available to families who are income eligible.

Pre-K Counts is for children between three and four years of age. Children must be ready to enter kindergarten within one or two years.

Pre-K Counts may be a half-day or full day but always in a STAR Three or STAR Four program.

Pre-K Counts has a limited number of openings each year.

Pre-K Counts staff know that early education will make children more ready to learn and more successful when they enter school.



▶ Who may apply for the Pre-K Counts program?

Residents of Bucks County may apply for the Pre-K Counts program if they meet the financial guidelines per their 2011 Federal Income tax return.

The income limit for a family of four is approximately \$56,000.

The first two pages of your 2011 income tax form or other acceptable income verification must be included with your completed application.

After financial guidelines are met, other risk factors will be considered.
